

CITY OF MUSKOGEE

POLICY

OKLAHOMA SELF DEFENSE ACT

OKLAHOMA STATUTES, TITLE 21, SECTION 1290-1, et. seq.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1996

It shall be the policy of the City of Muskogee to prohibit the following:

1. All weapons, including concealed firearms, are strictly prohibited in all City owned facilities by employees of the City of Muskogee.
2. Weapons, including concealed firearms, are strictly prohibited in any City owned vehicle.
3. The possession of weapons and/or firearms on the person or in the possession of any City employee while on duty is strictly prohibited.

Weapons are defined as any pistol, revolver, firearm, dagger, bowie knife, dirk knife, switch blade knife, spring-type knife, sword cane, knife having a blade which opens automatically by hand pressure applied to a button, spring, or other device in the handle of the knife, blackjack, loaded cane, billy, hand chain, metal knuckles or any other offensive weapons.

Firearms are defined as a weapon capable of discharging a projectile composed of any material which may reasonably be expected to cause any injury.

Penalty: Violation of this policy by a City employee will result in disciplinary action which may include dismissal.

LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS POLICY.
